#### The Simple Payment Plan

In 2018, new legislation allowed us to trial the Simple Payment Plan, for customers who find it most difficult to pay.

Customers who qualify can choose from a variety of payment plans that spread the cost of a TV licence over 12 months.



#### **Going Paperless**

You don't need a paper licence, you already have one stored online. If you pay by Direct Debit or one annual payment, you can switch to an e-licence.
