

**IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE BBC TO OVER 75s**  
**REGARDING YOUR FREE TV LICENCE**

**If you are aged 75 or over and have a free BBC television licence please read this important notice\*.**

In March this year, the BBC, with the Government's agreement, decided to delay the changes to over 75s licence fees until 31 July 2020 due to the Coronavirus.

**This means that if you are aged 75 or over and hold a free BBC TV licence which expires on 31 May 2020, your licence will last a further two months until 31 July 2020. This will happen automatically. This notice formally extends your free TV licence and you do not need to contact TV Licensing about this or take any further action.**

We would also like to inform you that if you are currently aged 74 and turn 75 between 1 June and 31 July 2020, you can apply for a free TV licence which will expire on 31 July 2020. The BBC Board will continue to keep this matter under review.

\*This Notice is published pursuant to the BBC's power to modify a TV licence in this way in section 364(5)(b) of the Communications Act 2003.
